## Bee keeping experience

Bee keeping experience - The experience will involve visiting bee hives in an apiary within a 5- minute drive of Bilton.

Together with me you will enter into each colony where I will identify the different bee types within a colony.

(The queens are not always easy to see so I can't promise seeing a queen.) We will look at the different types of 'cell' within a colony, note the location of different types of food including honey and see the different stages of larva (young bees). You will get the opportunity to taste honey straight from the comb.

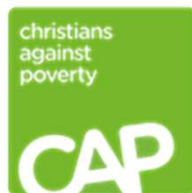
During the visit I will explain various aspects of beekeeping including history and challenges.

I will provide the suit and gloves; you need to provide wellingtons or other 'boot' like footwear.

I will ask you to drive to my home and then I will drive you to the apiary to be visited.

The visit will last at least an hour but come prepared for at least 2 hours.

The experience is for 4 people (over 18 years only) however it will be one person at a time over four individual visits.

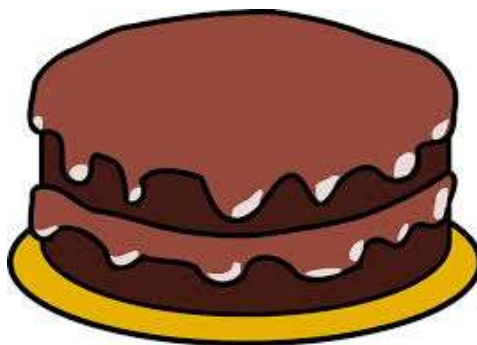

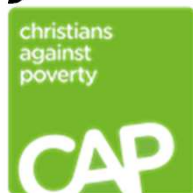
